

Thousands came to Christ under his evangelistic influence while he served as the pastor of the New Park Street Chapel and the Metropolitan Tabernacle in London, England. Without the aid of microphones or modern technologies, Charles Spurgeon pastored a flock of more than six thousand members, the largest

single congregation known to exist prior to his ministry. During this same period he helped to start more than forty other churches and oversaw the Pastor's College and the Stockwell Orphanage. During his lifetime, he was a major influence on the lives of many great Christian leaders including Dwight Moody, Hudson Taylor, George Mueller, and Oswald Chambers. Spurgeon's writings have sold millions worldwide including a continual republication of more than two thousand of his best sermons. Although he is often referred to as the 'Prince of Preachers,' his words of Godgiven insight have blessed many more laypeople than pastors. But they returned it to me and said that they knew all about it and that I must come. Ah, what a story it has been since then of the goodness and loving-kindness of the Lord!
